DESSERT WINES

31 Vat 5 Botrytis Semillon De Bortoli (NSW, Australia)
Straw flavour from the Semillon grape combined with floral, honey and light apricot characteristics imparted from the botrytis give this wine a complex palate.

32 Late Harvest Sauvignon Blanc (Chile)
This wine is made from Sauvignon Blanc grapes. Heavy rains were experienced during the late harvest of the grapes, bringing as a consequence a higher level of sugar than normal. The result is a wine with a complex taste of honey, together with a special feeling of mature fruit. £16.95 125ml £5.75

33 Prosecco Domaine de Bertiol, Montresor (Italy)
A lovely light aromatic nose leads to a confident, creamy lemon-tanged palate and a bright, lively finish.

34 Langlois-Chateau Cremant de Loire Rose (France)
Softly pink hued with small, persistent bubbles & mouth watering white peach aromas. Lots of fruit on the palate with light floral character. £19.95

CHAMPAGNES

35 Gremillet Brut
Characteristic toasty yeast overtones are balanced by richer fruit & classic baked biscuit flavours with a crisp citrus finish. £29.50

36 Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut
Superb marriage of freshness and power – a poised, delicately bready nose – and on the palate a richness of fruit and mouth filling mousse that lingers long. £45.00

37 Bollinger Rose
A completely new Rose from Champagne Bollinger. The creation of this non vintage Rose has been long in the making and a dream of the House for over six years.

38 Bollinger La Grande Annee

Bollinger's prestigious cuvee, la Grande Annee is only made when the vintage is outstandingly good. A full-bodied powerful Champagne of complexity with a clean long finish. £125.00

39 Don Perignon

Moet's finest cuvee is a delightful pale golden yellow with a fine, impressive mousse. Aromas of brioche and honey tones quickly blend with fresh almonds and apricots. It is round, persistent, vibrant and pure.
