WHITE WINES

40 Puligny-Montrachet 1er Cru Sous le Puits Louis Latour (1999, Burgundy, France)

The wine is rich and opulent with a focused gout de terroir. The typical flavour of the wine of Sous le Puits is buttery rich with a spicy exotic fruit character and a crisp balancing acidity. The finish is lingering. £48.00

41 Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc

(2008, Marlborough, New Zealand)

Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc is reminiscent of a fresh summer fruit salsa – ripe peach, passion fruit, mango and juicy citrus – sprinkled with fresh fennel and a dash of Pastis. The palate is rich and succulent, with a zesty citrus and apple-herbert acidity that leads to a long, lingering, and characteristically crisp finish. £39.95

42 Francis Ford Coppola Directors Cut Russian River Chardonnay (2006 California, USA)

Profuse aromatics of honeysuckle, orange blossoms and ripe pear are folded into classic Russian River flavours of green apple, tropical fruit and citrus. £34.00

RED WINES

43 Château de Pez Cru Bourgeois Exceptionnel Saint Estephe (2003, Bordeaux, France)

Displays an impressive sense of balance with dense fruit, herbs, black currant jelly and delicious touches of new wood on the finish. £59.00

44 Monte Real Gran Reserva (1978, Spain)

Quite pale but still vibrant brick red, it is ethereal rather than powerful, delicate yet mouthfilling with a fine silky texture and multi-layered with aromas of dried fruits, cedar and brown spices. £45.95

45 Edizione Pennino Zinfandel, Rubicon Estate Francis Ford Coppola (2005, Napa Valley, USA)

Intense aromas of raspberry, white pepper and licorice are followed by sweet, mouth filling flavours of blue and red fruits, briar and spice. With a palate this dense and ripe, the profusion of flavour lingers and builds beautifully on the finish. £39.95

46 Chateau Cissac Haut Medoc (2004, Bordeaux, France)

Cabernet Sauvignon provides unmistakable aromas of cassis. Merlot and petit Verdot add plumpness and complexity in what is a most medon. £29.95
