ROSE WINES

16 Postales Malbec Rose (Patagonia)

An appealing Rose with fresh strawberry aromas. On the palate the wine shows delicious red berry fruit and a touch of spice. £16.50 250ml £5.75

17 Montecelli Pinot Grigio Rose (Italy)

A Pinot Grigio made with a touch of Pinot Noir adding depth to this light and refreshing style with subtle cherry and summer fruit flavours. £15.95 250ml £5.50

RED WINES

18 Emiliana Merlot (Chile)

Warm and supple, exhibiting rich fruit, soft tannins, a silky texture and plenty of weighty fruit. £13.95 175 ml £3.75 250ml £4.95

19 Martinez Laquesta Rioja Crianza (Spain)

This wine combines the subtle strawberry aromas so typical of the Tempranillo with the vanilla bouquet from the American oak. £18.95

20 Baron Phillippe de Rothschild Cabernet Sauvignon (Bordeaux)

Intense violet colour, very pleasant on the palate, with soft tannins. Good body. £16.50

21 The Crossings Pinot Noir

(Marlborough, New Zealand)

Elegant, classic. Ripe black cherry & strawberry notes laced with a richness of spice & oak overtones. £24.95

22 Fleurie Domaine la Madonne (Beaujolais, France)

A deep vibrant purple, this fleurie from Domaine de la Madonne has a lovely fruity spicy nose, gushing fruity flavours, and is smooth and velvety. £24.95

23 Mr Smith Shiraz (McLaren Vale, Australia)

A preposterously lush Shiraz from some of the gnarliest vines we have ever seen, produce this dense, dark, brooding and incredibly impressive wine. £24.95

24 Flag Tree Cabernet Malbec Merlot (Patagonia)

(Brilliant aroma with hints of blackberries & plum jam, very fruity on the palate, well balanced and long aftertaste) £14.95

25 Rooiberg Pinotage (South Africa)

Rooiberg Pinotage has an attractive deep colour and the typical full-flavoured style of rich Pinotage. It has lots of complex cultivar character, mingling well with good woodiness. £15.95

26 Marques de Murrieta Rioja Reserva (Spain)

A big, intense and powerful Rioja full of peppery fruit flavours and plenty of cedar wood and vanilla oak. £28.95

27 Novas Winemaker's Selection Syrah

(Casablanca, Chile)

Spicy white pepper and blackcurrant aromas, with tremendously rich red plum fruit and loads of pepper and spice and well integrated tannins. £23.95

28 Rive Barbera d'Asti (Piemonte, Italy)

An abundance of vibrant red currants, black cherries and a touch of spice show through on the palate, which has a rich voluptuous texture balancing taught acidity; and fine oak tanins. £23.95

29 Cote du Rhone Parallele 45 Jaboulet (Rhône, France)

Lovely aromatic, spicy fruit on the nose and in the mouth, reminiscent of raspberries, liquorice and pepper, medium bodied and rounded but quite soft, just a tad of dry grip to finish. £19.95

30 Plantagenet Pinot Noir (Western Australia)

On the palate light bodied with flavours of strawberry, spice and some mulchy earthy flavours. It has fresh tangy acid and light dry tannins. £19.95
