- 1 Caracara Sauvignon Blanc** £17.95
Light and elegant style with citrus & green
fruits and gentle acidity (Chile) 175ml £4.95
250ml £6.50
- 2 Meerstein Chenin Pinot Grigio** £18.95
A delightfully pure, balanced marriage of Chenin
Blanc's rich guava fruit lifted by the bright, refreshing
appeal of Pinot Grigio (South Africa) 250ml £6.75
- 3 Muscadet sur Lie Vieilles Vignes Domaine de la
Briaudière** £23.95
Delicate aromas of stone and citrus fruit and a fresh, fruity palate with
a lasting finish
(Loire, France)
- 4 Terrazze della Luna Pinot Grigio** £24.95
Floral nose with fruity notes hinting at banana
and pineapple. Nice white fruit on the palate with
fresh acidity on the finish (Trentino, Italy) 175ml £6.95
- 5 d'A Chardonnay, Paul Mas** £23.95
An intense nose of tropical and dry
fruit characters precedes an archetypal
nutty palate with delicate vanilla notes
(Vin de Pays, France) 175ml £6.75
- 6 Makutu Sauvignon Blanc** £25.95
Vibrant gooseberry and passion fruit aromas with excellent balance, an
intense flavour and a lengthy finish (Marlborough, New Zealand)
- 7 Picpoul de Pinet, Duc de Morny** £23.50
Exuberant fresh on the palate with ripe mango fruit, a slightly salty edge
and underlying minerality (Languedoc, France)
- 8 Domaine Astruc Viognier, Paul Mas** £23.95
Smooth and weighty, quite mouth filling. A beautifully balanced wine
with all the fresh, fruity flavours coupled with the exotic (Vin de Pays,
France)

9 Chablis, Domaine de la Motte £32.50

Fresh and crisp with citrus and mineral notes. The wine has a leesy character and a nutty finish with plenty of fresh acidity (Burgundy, France)

10 Macon-Villages, Chateau de Mirande £29.95

Made from vines growing between the communes of Lugny and Viré, this wine is a perfect balance of roundness and intensity. Suffused with spicy, floral and fruity notes that linger pleasantly to the finish (Burgundy, France)

11 Sancerre, Domaine Girard £34.50

Aromas of grapefruit and citrus on the nose. Full and round in the mouth with fruity grapefruit and orange flavours (Loire, France)

12 Orballo Albarino, Rias Baixas £28.50

A zesty, limey and pineapple nose. With bright peaches, apple fruit on the palate
(Rias Baixas, Spain)

13 Lugana San Vigilio, Podere Selva Cappuzza £24.95

This is a classic Lugana in its most traditional interpretation: delicate, floral and fruit driven with delicate palate and lingering, fresh finish (Lombardia, Italy)

14 Gavi di Gavi Nouvo Quadro £27.50

This single vineyard Gavi shows fresh and light zesty citrus notes on the palate that lift a textured well-rounded mouth feel (Piemonte, Italy)

15 Don Placero Rioja Blanco £20.95

Fresh and vibrant, with notes of green apples and pears and a riper layer of honey (Rioja, Spain)

ROSÉ WINES

16 Château Gairoid Rosé £28.50

This beautiful organic rosé is gastronomic and elegant with sweet fruit aromas and flavours of ripe peaches on the palate (Provence, France)

17 Allamanda Pinot Grigio Rosé £18.95

A light and refreshing style with subtle cherry and summer fruit flavours
(Italy)

RED WINES

- 18 Caracara Merlot** £17.95
Warm and supple, exhibiting rich fruit, soft tannins, a silky texture and plenty of weighty fruit (Chile)

- 19 Don Placero Rioja Tinto** £19.50
A blend of Tempranillo, Garnacha and Mazuelo. Navajas Rioja Tinto is vibrant with fruits of the forest flavours and vanilla oak (Rioja, Spain)
175ml £5.45
- 20 Bacca Negra Negroamaro Primitivo** £22.50
A modern styled red blending a little Primitivo with Negroamaro, giving a sweeter fruit feel. The small degree of the 'ripasso' method further boosts the richness of the mouthfeel (Salento, Italy)
- 21 Flagtree Malbec Cabernet Sauvignon Merlot** £19.95
Complex and elegant nose, with red berries and notes of vanilla and tobacco. In the mouth the wine is medium-full bodied with ripe dark fruit flavours and a hint of oaky spice (Patagonia, Argentina)
- 22 Fleurie, Jules de Souzy** £31.50
An elegant Fleurie where mineral notes complement ripe fruit and spicy nuances (Beaujolais, France)
- 23 Domaine Astruc Shiraz Viognier** £24.50
Dark redcurrant and blackcurrant fruit, the viognier in this wine really stands out with its perfume qualities which give more elegance (Languedoc, France)
- 24 Zapa Malbec** £22.50
A vibrant wine with an alluring blend of fruit along with clove, pepper and cinnamon spice finished off with well-structured integrated tannins (Mendoza, Argentina)
- 25 11th Hour Zinfandel** £25.50
This wine is well rounded with rich flavours of cranberry, plum and juicy blackberries. The wine finishes with spice, vanilla and cedar (California, USA)
- 26 Marques de Murrieta Rioja Reserva** £37.00
A big, intense and powerful Rioja full of peppery fruit flavours and plenty of cedar wood and vanilla oak (Rioja, Spain)

27 Paco Mulero Prisma Organic Monastrell

£27.50 Generous, rich and spicy with concentrated red and black fruit, supple tannins, and fresh acidity on the finish (Catalonia, Spain)

28 Jean Gamay Noir, Jean Loron **£24.50**

This is a brilliant re-imagining of Beaujolais. It's deeply coloured with fantastic fruit and beautifully smooth (Beaujolais, France)

29 Casal da Coelheira Reserva **£25.95**

Rich and concentrated, this top quality red has notes of dark fruit, chocolate, baking spices and leather. A full-bodied wine with firm but approachable tannins complemented by a velvety finish (Tejo, Portugal)

30 Midday Somewhere Shiraz, Hesketh **£24.50**

Dark fruit, spice, floral, sage, honey and shortbread aromas. Strawberries, violets with some brooding, savoury, spice adding complexity. Bright red fruits of strawberry and raspberry abound on the palate

(South Australia)

DESSERT WINES

31 Moscato Passito, Araldica **£13.95**

A nose of intense lemon meringue pie, marmalade, hard caramel and toffee apple. The palate has lots of ripe apricot and acacia honey characters with a core of homemade lemon curd running through to the long, fresh and lingering citrus finish. (Italy)

32 Domaine de Grange Neuve Monbazillac **500ml**

£17.95 A fabulous dessert wine, sweet and luscious with a backbone of fine acidity for a clean finish. The nose is fresh with classic botrytis marmalade and ripe nectarine and melon, flavours on the palate are richer, honey and toffee finishing with a twist of bitter orange zest (France)

SPARKLING WINES

33 Vispo Allegro Prosecco **£23.95**

A deliciously light and fruity Prosecco with hints of apple and peach on the nose and a fresh, softly sparkling palate (Italy)

34 Lunetta Spumante Rosé **£24.95**

A fresh and dry sparkling rosé with red berry characters on the nose and palate making this soft and approachable in character (Italy)

CHAMPAGNES

35 Hansons House Champagne **£35.00**

A clean, fresh floral bouquet with a hint of hazelnut, leads to a delicate yet refreshing citrus palate and a long, balanced and rounded finish (France)

36 Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut **£55.00**

Superb marriage of freshness and power – a poised, delicately breadly nose – and on the palate a richness of fruit and mouth filling mousse that lingers long (France)

37 Veuve Clicquot Brut Rosé **£75.00**

Madame Clicquot created the first blended Rosé in 1818 by adding some red wine to Yellow Label champagne. The result was Veuve Clicquot Rosé, a fruity and full-bodied expression of the Veuve Clicquot style (France)

38 Bollinger Rosé **£95.00**

A completely new Rose from Champagne Bollinger. The creation of this non vintage Rose has been long in the making and a dream of the House for over six years (France)

39 Bollinger La Grande Annee **£139.00**

Bollinger's prestigious cuvee, la Grande Annee is only made when the vintage is outstandingly good. A full-bodied powerful Champagne of complexity with a clean long finish (France)

40 Dom Perignon **£190.00**

Moet's finest cuvee is a delightful pale golden yellow with a fine, impressive mousse. Aromas of brioche and honey tones quickly blend with fresh almonds and apricots. It is round persistent, vibrant and pure (France)

FINE WINES

WHITE WINES

41 Puligny-Montrachet Domaine Jean Pascal et Fils £65.00

After spending 10 months on its lees in oak barrel (20% new), this Puligny is clean and intense, bursting with ripe tropical fruit characteristics yet with a lovely buttery finish (Burgundy, France)

42 Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc £42.50

Reminiscent of a fresh summer fruit salsa – ripe peach, passion fruit, mango and juicy citrus – sprinkled with fresh fennel and a dash of Pastis. The palate is rich and succulent, with a zesty citrus and applesherbert acidity that leads to a long, lingering, and characteristically crisp finish
(Marlborough, New Zealand)

43 Montagny 1er Cru 'Vignes Derriere' Pierres Sauvages £39.50

A delicious, fresh Chardonnay which has been fermented and matured in stainless steel tanks to preserve the pure peach, pear and acacia aromas. Soft and rich on the palate (Burgundy, France)

44 Chateau la Foliette Muscadet Sevre det Maine Sur Lie £29.95

This is Muscadet with a difference though and unlike almost any other you will taste it has in spades the crisp zingy citrus tang we look for from this region, as well as the stony, seaspray freshness but also an extra level of bright fruit, mineral richness and layers of flavour we don't often find in a Muscadet
(Loire, France)

FINE WINES

We have put together a selection of some interesting and very fine wines for your enjoyment

RED WINES

45 Clos Laborie, Margaux

£59.00

More than any other Left Bank commune, Margaux is all about perfume - like this wine's nose of crushed red berries, roasted coffee, crushed herb, cedar and spice that keep on pumping out these deliciously complex notes on the clear, focused, palate. Graphite and tobacco come up with air and linger over the firm tannins and ripe fruit on the finish (Bordeaux, France)

46 Imperial Reserva Rioja, CVNE

£45.95

This Reserva is a careful selection of perfectly ripe Tempranillo grapes, from superb vineyards in Rioja Alta, some Graciano adds more finesse and polish while a little Mazuelo brings depth and colour. Two years in French and American oak casks has softened this lovely wine leaving it fragrantly aromatic and spicy with underlying rich fruit and a savoury palate with balance and elegance on the long and complex finish (Rioja, Spain)

47 Clos du Val Zinfandel

£39.95

This zesty zinfandel has a deep ruby red hue. Brambly notes of spice, minerals, black pepper & cherry marry with some subtle tobacco aromas (Napa Valley, California, USA)

48 Nuits-Saint-Georges, Jaffelin

£65.95

Red fruit fragrances, such as red currants and raspberries, clearly express the characteristics of the terroir. Full and fruity on the palate, with great length. The tannins are silky but can still be felt (Burgundy, France)
